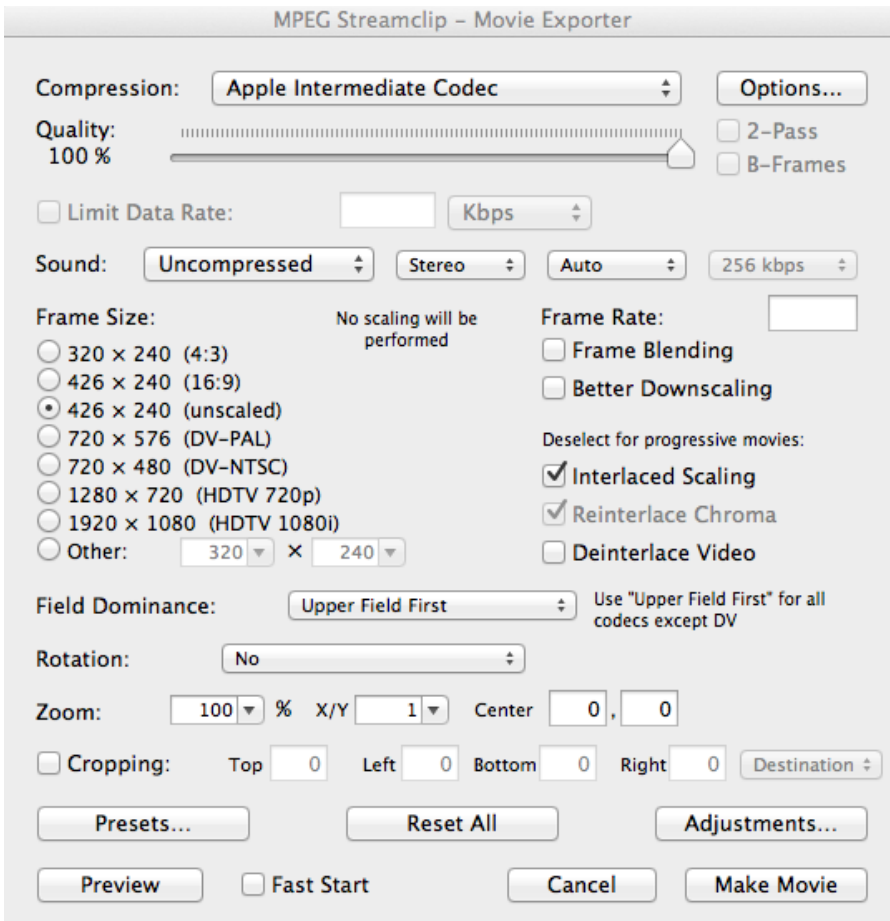
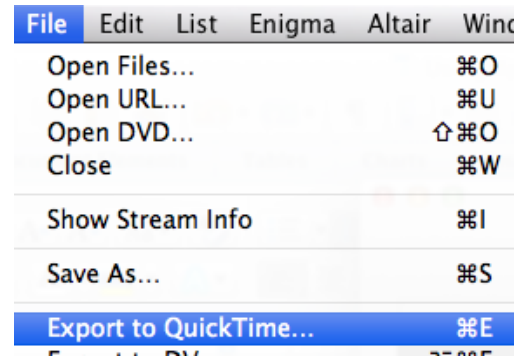
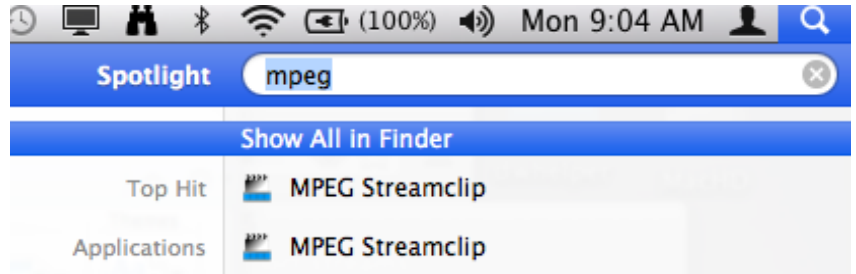


How to Render First

One of the biggest hassles in Macintosh video production is dealing with the many video formats. Using Final Cut, one often has to wait for a clip to render. It is possible to create videos that are “native” to FC and do not require rendering. The program to convert is called “MPEG Streamclip.”

Steps to convert 1 clip.

1. Launch MPEG Streamclip
2. Drag the video into the large gray window with the 5 blue dotted dice
3. Go to File > Export to QuickTime
4. Use the settings below
5. Give the converted video a logical name and save it into your project folder.
6. Import the converted video into FC.
